TRAINING AND PLACEMENT CELL

Annual Report (2025–2026)

The Training and Placement Cell of Loyola College of Arts and Science has actively organized various training programmes, orientation sessions, and industry interactions during the academic year 2025–2026 with the objective of enhancing students' employability skills and preparing them for successful careers.

The academic year commenced with a **Two-Day Placement Training Session** on 8th and 9th September 2025. The programme was led by Dr. Princely Samuel, Director, Placement Cell, Loyola College. The sessions focused on understanding the placement process, company expectations, interview techniques, resume preparation, and professional etiquette. Department-wise placement opportunities were discussed, and a target of 50 placements was set for the academic year.

On 15th December 2025, a **Career Guidance and Placement Orientation Programme** was conducted for final-year students. The session was handled by Mr. Prabhushankar, Dean – Placement, Loyola-ICAM College of Engineering and Technology. He guided students on career planning, higher education options, skill development, and effective resume building.

From 16th to 18th December 2025, a **Three-Day Training Programme on Soft Skills and AI Tools** was organized in association with Magic Bus Foundation. Students were divided into four groups, and trainers provided intensive training on communication skills, personality development, workplace readiness, mock interviews, and practical exposure to AI tools.

An **HR Talk** was organized on 20th December 2025 for all third-year students. Three HR professionals from reputed industries addressed the students in separate groups, sharing insights on recruitment trends, corporate expectations, workplace ethics, and career growth opportunities. The interactive sessions helped bridge the gap between academic learning and industry requirements.

On 22nd December 2025, a **One-Day Orientation Programme on Artificial Intelligence and Soft Skills** was conducted for Science department girl students in collaboration with Nirmaan Organization. The session created awareness about emerging AI technologies and the importance of interpersonal skills in the professional world.

Further strengthening this initiative, a **Five-Day Placement Training Programme on Soft Skills and Artificial Intelligence** was held from 19th to 23rd January 2026. Around 104 students enrolled, and 82 students actively participated in mock interviews. The training provided hands-on exposure to AI concepts, communication skills, interview etiquette, and workplace readiness.

Overall, the Training and Placement Cell has made consistent efforts to equip students with technical knowledge, soft skills, and industry exposure. Through structured training programmes, expert sessions, and collaborative initiatives, the Cell continues to work towards improving placement opportunities and enhancing the career preparedness of students.
