## NSS ANNUAL REPORT – 2021

### 1. Free COVID-19 Vaccination Camp – I

- **Date:** 07.09.2021
- **Venue:** College Campus
- **In Association with:** PHC, Mangalapuram

As per the guidance of the District Collector of Namakkal, a one-day free COVID-19 vaccination camp was organized by the NSS Unit. The objective of the camp was to ensure immunization among students and the local community during the pandemic period.

Students aged 18 and above, teaching and non-teaching staff, and residents from nearby villages actively participated. NSS volunteers played a vital role in registration, crowd management, and guiding beneficiaries.

Strict COVID-19 safety measures such as wearing masks, maintaining social distancing, and regular sanitization were followed throughout the programme. A team of doctors, nurses, and paramedical staff administered vaccines to **146 beneficiaries** successfully.

### 2. Free COVID-19 Vaccination Camp – II

- **Date:** 16.12.2021

The second phase of the vaccination drive was conducted to ensure complete vaccination coverage. The NSS volunteers once again supported the medical team by organizing registration desks and ensuring smooth flow of participants.

The camp witnessed enthusiastic participation from students, staff members, and the general public. Awareness about the importance of vaccination was also spread during the programme.

More than **150 beneficiaries** received the vaccine, contributing significantly to public health safety.
