He was honored by the management. The Day I sessions included topics such as Understanding the Placement Process, Company Expectations and Skill Gaps, Interview Techniques and Preparation Strategies, and Etiquette and Professionalism. The programme concluded with a reflection and Q&A session, where students actively participated and expressed that the training had enriched their confidence and preparedness for interviews.
